

INTERVIEW TIPS/QUESTION IDEAS

A nanny interview is usually an informal chat, to see if you and the family get along well and can form a good working relationship.

They will ask you questions, it's only natural, so maybe have a think about the following:

- Tell the family about you, previous experience and what you like to do in your spare time.
- Why did you apply for this position?
- Have you worked with this age group/area before? Maybe share some examples
- Depending on the age of the children, have you researched the area for local groups, local parks, library, leisure centre etc? Maybe take a small list of ideas
- Brush up on first aid skill to be able to answer any questions
- Have a think of any questions you want to ask expenses, what is expected of you, have the children got any allergies/medical conditions etc
- Perhaps tell them about any pre booked holidays you have.

Things you might want to take along with you.

- File with certificates in, DBS, any written references, any thank you cards from the children, maybe some ID (passport/driving licence)
- A list of groups you would like to attend, or days out in the holidays
- Examples of meals you're prepared to cook for the children/family
- Anything else you're proud of.
